Directorate of Small Savings & Lotteries

1. Vision:

The aim of the Directorate of Small Savings & Lotteries is to generate more revenue to the Government by conducting the Goa State Lotteries.

2. Objective:

The Government of Goa conducts the Online and Paper Lotteries through this Department by appointing Marketing Agent for Selling/Distributing the Goa State Online & Paper Lotteries. The lottery activity generates additional revenue to the Government of Goa, augments the additional financial resources for the State with a view to fund various public utilities, Social Welfare Schemes and creation of public asset such as roads, bridges, schools and hospitals etc.

The Goa State Lotteries are being re-launched in the month of November, 2020, coinciding with the festival season in India.

As a Social Welfare Schemes, the Government through this Department has released the Grand-in-Aid of Rs.1350.00 lakhs (Rupees Thirteen Crore Fifty Lakhs Only) under the Social Security and Welfare Programme to the Institute of Public Assistance (Providoria) during the year 2019-20 and Rs.607.50 Lakhs Rupees six crores seven lakhs fifty thousand only) till date for the current financial year 2020-21 for implementation of its various welfare schemes for the poor and under privileged and maintenance of old age homes and asylums in South Goa and North Goa.

The Directorate of Small Savings & Lotteries, Government of Goa, Altinho Panaji is only renewing the Agencies under the Small Savings.

3. Short Term goals: (to be achieved by 2021)

The Department will achieve revenue of Rs.21.02 crore during the financial year 2020-21.

4. Medium Term goals: (to be achieved by 2023)

The Directorate will earn more revenue by re-tendering of the EOI for 2 sets of draws which have remained without bid.

5. Long Term goals: (to be achieved by 2025)

Efforts will be taken for increasing the productivity thereby increasing the revenue to the Government

6. Action Plan:

The Department will take initiative to conduct the Goa State Lottery drawn on Computerized Draw Machine once the software is developed by the DOIT.
